

EXTRA PERIODS – 2007

CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION

#	PLAY	RULING
1	On the first series, A4's field goal attempt is tipped behind the neutral zone. B28 attempts to catch the kick in B's end zone and muffs the ball. B42 picks up the ball just short of B's end line and advances the length of the field across A's goal line.	Touchdown. The game is over. Team B wins.
2	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances to B's 14 where he is downed. A26 was illegally in motion.	The series ends. Team B declines the penalty for A26's foul. The penalty is not enforced on the next series. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25.
3	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances to A's 10 where he is hit and fumbles. Team A recovers and is downed in the field of play.	The series ends. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
4	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances to A's 10 where he is hit and fumbles. Team A recovers and advances across Team B's goal line. A26 was illegally in motion.	The penalty is accepted. There is no score. Team A next puts the ball in play after a 5-yard penalty from the previous spot. (NOTE: Last known interpretation.)
5	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances to A's 10. Team A commits a personal foul during Team B's advance.	Distance penalties for live ball fouls by either team after Team B possession are declined by rule. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
6	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances to A's 10. Team A commits a flagrant personal foul during the advance.	Distance penalties for live ball fouls by either team after Team B possession are declined by rule. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10. The offending player is disqualified.
7	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances to A's 10. Team A commits a personal foul and also a taunting foul during the advance.	The penalty for the live ball personal foul is declined by rule. The taunting foul is a live ball foul penalized as a dead ball foul. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 12 1/2, 1st and 10.

CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION

#	PLAY	RULING
8	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances to A's 10 where he is hit and fumbles. Team A recovers while grounded. Team A commits a personal foul and Team B commits a taunting foul during Team B's advance.	The penalty for the live ball personal foul is declined by rule. The taunting foul is a live ball foul penalized as a dead ball foul. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 40, 1st and 10.
9	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team A and Team B both foul after the change of team possession.	No score. The down is not replayed. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
10	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team A fouls any time during the down.	Game over. Team B wins.
11	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team B holds during the advance.	No score. The penalty is declined by rule. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
12	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team A and Team B both foul before the change of team possession.	No score. Both fouls occurred <u>before</u> a change of team possession. Offsetting fouls; penalties cancel. Replay the down at the previous spot.
13	On the first series, Team A's field goal attempt is blocked. Team B recovers, advances and fumbles. Team A recovers in the field of play while grounded.	End of series. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
14	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team A fouls prior to the change of team possession and Team B fouls during Team B's advance.	No score. The down is not replayed. Rule 10-1-4-Exception 1 does not apply in extra periods. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
15	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team B fouls prior to the change of team possession and Team A fouls during Team B's advance.	No score. The down is not replayed. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.

#	PLAY	RULING
16	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team B holds during Team B's advance and Team A fouls after the ball is dead.	No score. The penalty for the live ball holding foul is declined by rule. The penalty for Team A's dead ball foul is enforced from the succeeding spot. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 12 1/2, 1st and 10.
17	On the first series, Team B gains possession and advances for an apparent touchdown. Team B commits a blocking in the back foul during the advance and Team B commits a personal foul after the ball is dead.	No score. The penalty for the live ball blocking in the back foul is declined by rule. The penalty for Team B's dead ball foul is enforced from the succeeding spot. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 40, 1st and 10.
18	On the first series, Team B intercepts a legal forward pass in the field of play and retreats into B's end zone (no momentum) where he is downed.	Team A scores two points. Team B puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
19	On the first series, Team B intercepts a legal forward pass in the field of play and retreats into B's end zone (no momentum) where he is downed. Team B clips in B's end zone during Team B's run.	Team A scores two points from the result of the play. The penalty is declined by rule. Team B puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
20	On the first series, Team B intercepts a legal forward pass in the field of play and retreats into B's end zone (no momentum). Team B then advances into the field of play where he is downed. Team B clips in B's end zone during Team B's run.	No safety and no points for Team A. The penalty is declined by rule. Team B puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
21	On the first series, Team A scores a touchdown. B96 blocks the try and advances across A's goal line. During B96's run, A55 commits a flagrant personal foul.	The score is A6-B2. Disqualify A55. The penalty is declined by rule. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
22	On the first series, Team B gains possession and runs for an apparent touchdown. During Team B's advance, a Team B player is guilty of an unsportsmanlike act.	Score is cancelled by rule. The penalty for Team B's dead ball foul (live ball foul enforced as dead ball foul) is enforced from the succeeding spot. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 40, 1st and 10.

#	PLAY	RULING
23	On the first series, Team B gains possession, advances and fumbles. A66 recovers and runs for an apparent touchdown. During A66's advance, a Team A player is guilty of an unsportsmanlike act.	Score is cancelled by rule. The penalty for Team A's dead ball foul (live ball foul enforced as dead ball foul) is enforced from the succeeding spot. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 12-1/2, 1st and 10.
