

EXTRA PERIODS – 2007

NO CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION

#	PLAY	RULING
1	Team A scores a touchdown on the first series. Team A commits a live ball foul during the down.	No score. The penalty for Team A's foul is enforced per rule. Team A next puts the ball in play where the penalty leaves the ball unless it was 4th down and the penalty carries a loss of down.
2	Team A scores a touchdown on the first series. Team B commits a personal foul during the down.	Score counts. Team A's only options are to enforce the penalty on the try or decline the penalty. After the try, Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10. NOTE: Team A does not have the option to enforce the penalty to start the next series.
3	Team A scores a touchdown on the first series. Team B commits an incidental face mask foul during the down.	Score counts. The penalty is declined by rule since it is not a personal foul. A's ball, try, on or behind B's 3. After the try, Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
4	Team A scores a touchdown on the first series. Team A commits a taunting foul just prior to crossing the goal line.	Score counts. Team A's foul is a live ball foul penalized as a dead ball foul. Team B's only options are to enforce the penalty on the try or decline the penalty. A's ball, try, on B's 18. After the try, Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
5	Team A scores a touchdown on the first series. Team A commits a personal foul after the down ends and prior to the ready for play on the try.	Score counts. Team B may elect to enforce the penalty on the try or decline the penalty. A's ball, try, on B's 18. After the try, Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10. NOTE: Team B does not have the option to enforce the penalty to start the next series.
6	Team A scores a touchdown on the first series. Team B commits a noncontact foul after the down ends and prior to the ready for play on the try.	Score counts. Team A's only options are to enforce the penalty on the try or decline the penalty. After the try, Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.

NO CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION

#	PLAY	RULING
7	Team A scores a touchdown on the first series. The one-point try is successful. Team B roughs the kicker or commits a different personal foul.	Team A may accept the half-distance penalty on a retry and go for two points. Or, Team A may accept the point and the penalty will be enforced for Team B's series. Team B will put the ball in play from the 40.
8	Team A kicks a field goal on the first series. Team B roughs the kicker or commits a different personal foul	Team A may wipe out the three points and accept the 15-yard penalty (probably half-the-distance) from the previous spot with an automatic first down. Or, Team A can take the three points by declining the penalty. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
9	During a field goal attempt, the field goal attempt is blocked and rolls beyond the neutral zone where it is muffed by B57. Team A recovers the ball in the field of play.	Team B did not gain possession of the ball. Team A's ball, first down, at the spot of recovery.
10	Team A kicks a field goal on the first series. Team B commits a live ball personal foul three yards or more beyond the neutral zone.	Postscrimmage kick enforcement does not apply during field goals in extra periods. Team A may accept the penalty enforced from the previous spot and retain the ball. Or, by declining the penalty, Team A will accept the three points for the field goal. Team B next puts the ball in play on the 25, 1st and 10.
11	During a field goal attempt, the ball is tipped behind the neutral zone. B28 attempts to catch the kick in B's end zone and muffs the ball. Team A recovers the ball in the field of play..	Team A has a first down at the spot of recovery. Team B did not gain possession of the ball. The ball remains a live ball after touching a Team B player prior to touching the ground in B's end zone. Team A scores a touchdown if they catch or recover the ball in B's end zone.
12	Harvard scores on the first series and kicks the extra point to make the score Harvard 7 Yale 0. Yale scores on the second series to make the score Harvard 7 Yale 6. Harvard commits defensive pass interference during the down.	The penalty is declined by rule since the Harvard foul is not a personal foul. Yale puts the ball in play from on or behind the 3-yardline for the try.

EXTRA PERIODS – 2007

NO CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION

#	PLAY	RULING
13	During the third extra period, Harvard scores on the first series and scores a one-point safety on the extra point. Yale scores on the second series. The try by placement passes between the uprights over the crossbar.	The try is not successful. The final score is Harvard 7 Yale 6. Beginning with the third extra period, a one-point try (although not illegal) will not score a point. COMMENT: Preventative officiating?
14	During the third extra period, Harvard scores on the first series and scores a one-point safety on the extra point. Yale scores on the second series. Yale lines up to attempt the try by placement. The holder takes the snap and with his knee on the ground, flips the ball forward to an offensive back who advances across Harvard's goal line.	The try is successful. The play is legal. The final score is Yale 8 Harvard 7.
15	Harvard fails to score on their first series. Yale moves the ball to the 9 where they attempt a field goal on 3rd down and goal. The kick is blocked. The kick does not cross the neutral zone. Yale recovers while grounded on the 17.	Yale's ball, 4th and goal. A second extra period would be played if it was 4th down.
16	Harvard fails to score on their first series. Yale moves the ball to the 9 where they attempt a field goal on 4th down and goal. The kick is blocked. The kick does not cross the neutral zone. Yale recovers behind the neutral zone and advances across Harvard's goal line.	The game is over. Yale wins. The game would also be over with Harvard the winner if Harvard recovers the kick and advances across Yale's goal line.
17	Harvard scores on the first series and makes the extra point to make the score Harvard 7 Yale 0. Yale scores on the second series to make the score Harvard 7 Yale 6. Yale's one-point try is successful. Harvard is offside on the try.	Yale may accept the half-distance penalty on a retry and go for two points. Or, Yale may decline the penalty and take the point. If the penalty is declined, the ball will be put in play from the 25 to start the next extra period.

NO CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION

#	PLAY	RULING
18	On the first series, Team A advances for an apparent touchdown. During Team A's advance, a Team A player is guilty of an unsportsmanlike act.	Touchdown. The penalty for Team A's live ball foul treated as a dead ball foul is enforced on the try. COMMENT: The touchdown would not count if the score came after a change of team possession during the down.
